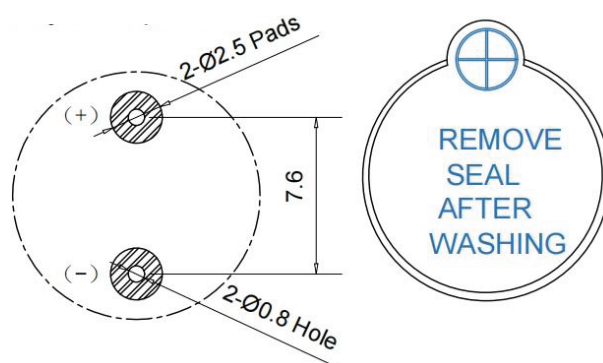
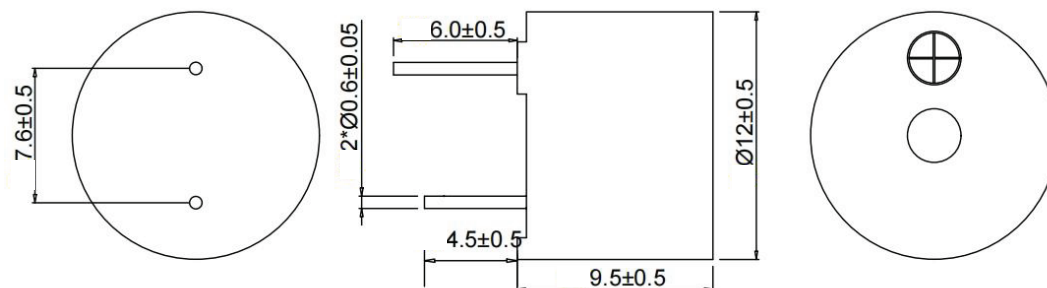

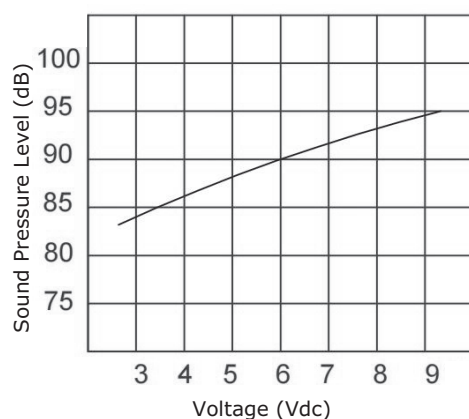

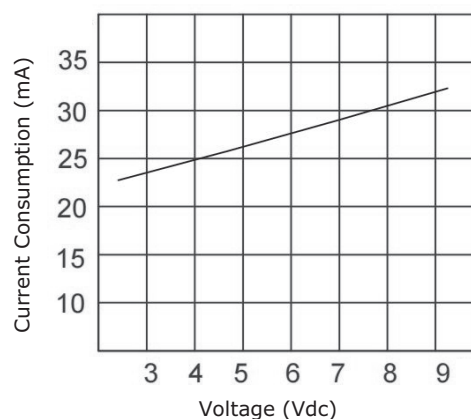
Recommended PCB Layout
